Recognizing that:

- The total cost for the rights to show the movie is 450 dollars, so FUSA will only be funding half the event.
- If this bill is approved this would be a FUSA co-sponsored event and would be advertised as such.
- There will be 150-200 people at this event.
- The event will be to inform students about Sigma Tau Delta and its purpose on campus. The Counte of Monte Cristo (2002) starring Jim Caviezel and Guy Pierce is “a remake of the Alexander Dumas tale by the same name. Dantes, a sailor who is falsely accused of treason by his best friend Fernand, who wants Dantes' girlfriend Mercedes for himself. Dantes is imprisoned on the island prison of Chateau d'If for 13 years, where he plots revenge against those who betrayed him. With the help of another prisoner, he escapes the

island and proceeds to transform himself into the wealthy Count of Monte Cristo as part of his plan to exact revenge” (IMDB). The Bishops rate the movie A-II for "implied affair, fleeting sexuality and intermittent sword fights and gunplay."
