- FUSA allocated \$2000.00 for two (2) issues in the Fall 2009 Budget
- The quote from the printer was \$1580.11 per issue for two-hundred fifty (250) copies, twenty (20) pages including cover
- \$580.11 per issue is required to cover the remainder of the costs
- Lumen Vincens is under new management this semester
- As of this date, Lumen Vincens does not have Advertising Income. Management will continue to search for new advertising clients
- Advertising Income in the past has averaged \$300 per issue
- Many Catholic colleges have literary magazines, including: Christendom College, VA, St. Thomas Aquinas College, CA, St. John's College, MD.
- Management is working on revamping the image of the magazine and has already completed the new logo, which was showcased on fliers earlier this semester.
- Submission rate matched last years. Twenty (20) submission were received and thirteen (13) will be printed. Management is developing strategies to increase submissions.
- Advertising for the upcoming issue will include: fliers and classroom chalkboard advertisements.
- All unused funds will be returned to the contingency fund
