- The FUS Pep Band was unable to receive funding from the athletic department for the upcoming season. Under the leadership of their newly elected treasurer, Stefanie Glover, they are currently planning fundraising for the entire season. With that said, they do need start up money to be successful in carrying out their mission.

- Under the direction of their student director and founding member, Jarett Kuhns, they are working towards the completion of their second successful season, and plan to return this year stronger than before.
